During the session, the YRC volunteers actively participated in plantation, road safety awareness, heritage conservation and blood donation activities.

1. Plantation Programme under “Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam.”

The Youth Red Cross unit organized a plantation programme on **17 September 2025** to celebrate the campaign “**Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam.**” The programme aimed to create environmental awareness among students and encourage them to contribute towards a greener and cleaner society.
